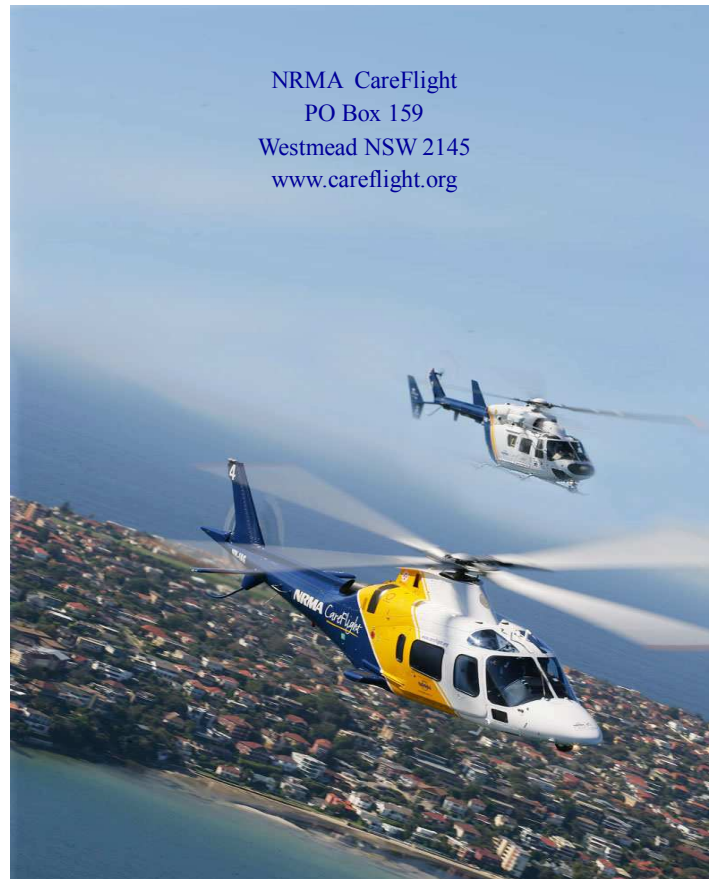

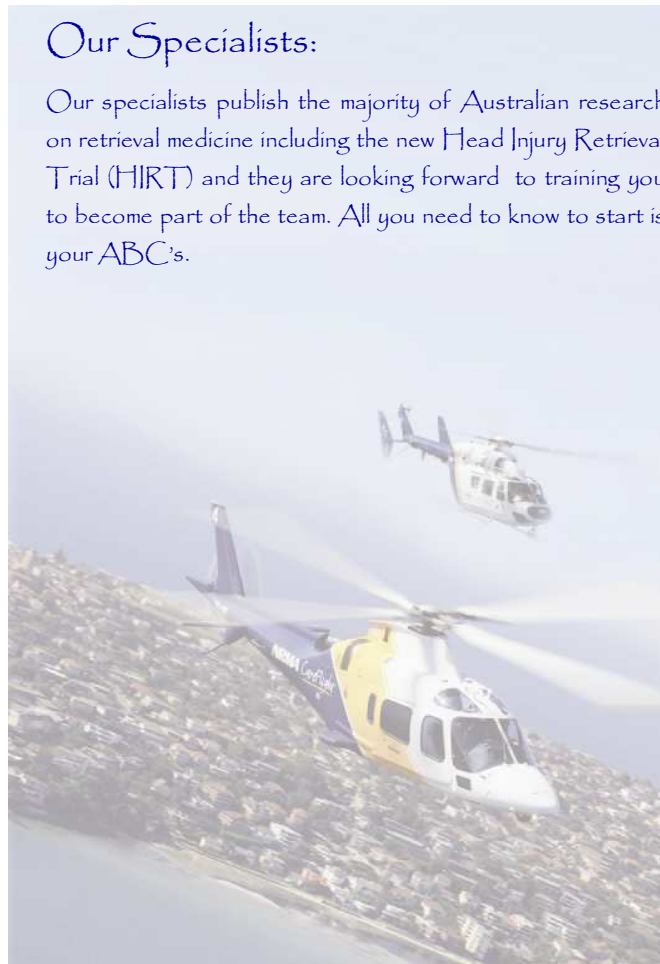
'Come and meet our team at NRMA CareFlight'

- rotate to the Head Injury Retrieval Trial (HIRT) to be the HIRT registrar with 1:1 specialist supervision.
