

DOCTOR DUTIES

Duty Doctor

- must be at the operations base - Bankstown, Orange or Westmead - for the duration of their rostered duty period
- must complete a formal handover as duty doctor to incoming duty doctor – Bankstown only
- must ensure database is up to date following all missions
- must be available for missions as tasked according to ASNSW and Medical Retrieval Unit policies and procedures. Where a mission is semi-urgent or elective and tasked very close to changeover time, on agreement by all the parties, the mission can be deferred until the next shift to allow appropriate utilisation of manpower resources and fatigue management

On-call Doctor

- same responsibilities as duty doctor
- on-call from home, but **must** be within one hour's availability from time of call
- contactable at all times by the tasking coordinator.

Charter Jet On-call Doctor – Sydney (Westmead), Cairns and Darwin

- contactable at all times by CareFlight International Air Ambulance coordinator
- conduct retrievals as directed, accompanied by retrieval-trained flight nurse
- discuss all cases with the on-call medical director for CareFlight International Air Ambulance
