



AeroMedical Pilot (ME Fixed Wing Captain)

SELECTION CRITERIA

Mandatory

- Australian Commercial Fixed Wing Licence; Class 1 Civil Aviation Medical Certificate; Night VFR endorsed; 2500 flying hours; 1500 hours PIC; 500 hours turbine engine fixed wing; 200 hours PIC night; 50 hours IFR; Command Instrument Rating for multi engine aircraft with three renewals.
- Australian permanent resident status.

Desirable

- Remote area experience; EMS experience; NT flying experience; ATPL (A); B200 endorsement;

Additional Criteria

- SC1** Demonstrated ability to work productively in a multi-crew environment or an environment where the applicant demonstrated the ability to act in a team leadership role.
- SC2** Australian Commercial Fixed Wing Licence; Class 1 Civil Aviation Medical Certificate; Night VFR endorsed; 2500 flying hours; 1500 hours PIC; 500 hours turbine engine fixed wing; 200 hours PIC night; 50 hours IFR; Command Instrument Rating for multi engine aircraft with three renewals.
- SC3** A working knowledge of aeromedical operations. Ability to operate in remote areas with limited supervision and proactively solve logistical and operational problems.
- SC4** Demonstrated ability to prepare written reports, computer skills, good interpersonal skills and oral communication skills.
- SC5** Experience working with emerging aviation technologies eg, Night and enhanced Vision Devices, GPS moving map systems, Glass cockpit systems.
- SC 6** Command experience flying fixed wing aircraft in a variety of environments/roles, eg, EMS, SAR, general charter.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Return of service obligations may apply.
- Completion of HUET training is an employment condition.
- Final appointment will be subject to a flying and oral assessment by the Head of Check and Training or his delegate.
- There may be a requirement to undertake relief duties at other CareFlight Bases.
- The position will involve rostered shift duties.
- Roster changes may occur at short notice.
- Emergency, Search and Rescue and Counter Disaster Operations may involve extended duty periods and/or protracted absences from home base.
- Travel may be a requirement of the position.
- Smoking is prohibited.
- Copies of all relevant certificates and qualifications are to be attached.
- All applications received after 5.00 pm on the closing date will be marked as late.
- Applications will remain current for 12 months.
- Applicants are requested to forward one (1) original plus three (3) copies of their application.
- CareFlight has a Drug and Alcohol policy. Pre employment testing is required under CASR Pt99. Employees are subject to random workplace testing.
