

REGISTRAR ROSTERS

Bankstown Base (ASNSW)

CareFlight provides 50% of the doctors to the Sydney basin and the Ambulance Service of NSW (ASNSW) provides 50%.

- 60% of rostered time spent at Bankstown Base
- 45% helicopter, 50% road ambulance and 5% fixed wing
- Mix of primary and inter-hospital transfers
- Registrars work four to five shifts per week/weekend
- Rosters comprise a mix of day and night shifts:
 - Day shifts: 07:30 hours – 19:30 hours
 - Night shifts: 19:30 hours – 07:30 hours

Orange Base (ASNSW)

CareFlight provides 100% of the doctors to the Orange base.

- 10% of rostered time spent at Orange base
- 94% helicopter and 6% road ambulance
- Equal split between pre-hospital and inter-hospital transfers
- Registrars are rotated to the Orange base weekly
- Day only operation: 08:00 hours – 18:00 hours
- Registrars rotating to Orange base undertake medical retrievals in accordance with the policies and procedures of ASNSW
- Registrars are flown to Orange on commercial airlines
- Meal allowance is paid per day
- Excellent accommodation is provided. Two bedroom apartment in centre of town, encouraged to bring family
- Car is provided for personal use



Westmead (CareFlight) – Head Injury Retrieval Trial (HIRT)

- 10% of rostered time spent as the primary care giver, supervised 1:1 with a senior specialist
- Randomised trial to head injured patients
- Automatically tasked to children
- Registrars are rotated to HIRT weekly
- Day only operation: hours vary from summer to winter with daylight saving

CareFlight International Air Ambulance – Sydney (Westmead) and Darwin

- 20% of rostered time spent being on call for CareFlight International Air Ambulance Secondary transfers utilising dedicated air ambulance jets in Sydney (Westmead) and Darwin Predominantly inter-hospital transfers from the South Pacific and South East Asia. Also transfers on commercial airlines to long haul destinations
- Registrars are rotated to either Sydney (Westmead) or Darwin weekly
- Roster commences 08:00 Monday – Monday 08:00
- Equipment checks are undertaken at 08:00 hours Monday morning with the registrar being on-call from home or, in the case of Darwin, at the base
- Registrars are flown to Darwin on commercial airlines

- Car is provided for personal use in Darwin
- Meal allowance is paid per day for Darwin
- Excellent accommodation is provided in Darwin. Brand new four bedroom apartment located in the centre of Darwin with harbour views, includes two pools and a gym. You share with the CareFlight team of pilot, aircrewman and, on occasion, engineer. Alternate accommodation would need to be sourced if bringing family.
