

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR NRMA CAREFLIGHT VENTURES (MOTORING EVENTS)

## 1. NRMA CareFlight & NRMA Logos.

The copying of, or use (in whole or in part) of NRMA CareFlight and/or NRMA logos or any other intellectual property belonging to NRMA CareFlight and/or NRMA is not permitted.

## 2. Entrant Numbers and Event Vehicle Stickers

Where provided, entrant numbers and event vehicle stickers must be displayed as advised and are not to obscure normal vision. You will receive further instructions with the numbers and stickers, if issued.

## 3. Drink Driving

We recognise that the event is a social event. However the irresponsible consumption of alcohol will not be tolerated. In the interests of your safety, your passengers and that of other road users, the event organisers will make available a handheld breathalyser unit for drivers/riders at morning checkpoints. The irresponsible consumption of alcohol will lead to expulsion from an event.

## 4. Illicit Drugs

The use of illicit drugs will not be tolerated by any person attending any NRMA CareFlight Venture. The use of illicit drugs will lead to expulsion from an event.

## 5. Drivers/Riders License

All drivers/riders must have a current NSW or interstate equivalent Drivers/Riders license.

## 6. Entry Donations

Donations to NRMA CareFlight are tax deductible. All entrants in an NRMA CareFlight Venture must have paid to NRMA CareFlight either personally or through donations from third parties, the full entry fees at least seven days prior to the start of the event.

## 7. Entry Withdrawal

Should an entrant need to withdraw their entry prior to the event they must notify the CareFlight Events Manager in writing prior to the start of the event. Any entry donations already paid to NRMA CareFlight up until the time of withdrawal will be receipted and credited against a later event.

## 8. Indemnity

Being a participant in an NRMA CareFlight Venture has a certain amount of risk attached. By being involved in an NRMA CareFlight Venture, participants, passengers and their guardians accept that there is a degree of risk and release CareFlight, its staff, contractors and volunteers from any responsibility or legal liability associated with their participation in the event, or the actions of other participants present or participating in the event.

## 9. Registration

All vehicles entered in NRMA CareFlight Ventures must be roadworthy, registered and third party (Green Slip) insured as prescribed by State laws.

## 10. Insurance

All vehicles entered in NRMA CareFlight 4WD Ventures must, at minimum, carry CTP and third party property motor vehicle insurance. All entrants are advised to discuss their participation in the event with their insurer to check if their policy covers such activities.

## 11. Personal Conduct

Any NRMA CareFlight Venture participant who, in the opinion of the CareFlight Events Manager, engages in conduct or behaviour that prejudices, or has the potential to prejudice the reputation of CareFlight and/or its sponsors, or the safety of other participants or other road users, may be expelled from the event.

## 12. Receipts

Receipts will only be issued to the name printed on cheques or in the case of credit cards, the name of the credited card holder.

## 13. Traffic Laws

An NRMA CareFlight Venture event is not a race, nor a rally. All entrants are required to comply with all state traffic laws and regulations.

## 14. Safety Equipment

For your safety and that of other event participants and road users, additional safety equipment may be required. You will be issued with a list before the event if this is necessary.

## 15. Vehicle Recovery

CareFlight staff and volunteers will have basic recovery equipment to assist if requested. By entering this event you acknowledge that you are responsible for recovery of your vehicle and any expenses related to it. Any assistance provided by CareFlight Staff and or volunteers is entirely at your risk. (See clause 8 above.)
