Leaving a gift in your Will is easy

Of course, caring for your loved ones should come first and it's important to discuss your intentions to include CareFlight in your Will with them. Whether you're making a new Will, or simply amending an existing one (by adding a Codicil – an extra clause), we recommend that you seek professional advice from a solicitor to ensure that your wishes are met.

Should you decide to remember CareFlight in your Will, this can take several forms:

- A residual gift: the remainder or percentage of your Estate after your loved ones have been cared for.
- A percentage: a percentage of the residual or the entire Estate,
- · A pecuniary gift: a specific cash gift amount
- A specific asset gift: real estate, shares, bonds, or other articles of value

Suggested wording for your Will:

I gift (bequeath):

- The whole of my Estate OR
- The rest and residual of my Estate, for example, "thirty percent (30%)" OR
- The sum of (the actual amount should be shown in words and figures) OR
- Specific property or items;

free of all debts, duties and taxes to CareFlight Limited for its general purposes. The receipt of the Chief Executive Officer of CareFlight or other duly authorised officer shall be full and final discharge to my Executor for this gift, and my Executor shall not be bound to see the application thereof.
